NOTE: Under section 85 of the **Building Act 1993**, the adjoining owner must respond to a notice under section 84 of that Act by giving to the owner within 14 days a notice under section 85 of that Act -

- (a) agreeing to the proposed protection work; or
- (b) disagreeing with the proposed protection work; or
- (c) requiring more information.

Failure to respond will be taken as agreement to the proposed protection work.

In the case of (b) or (c) above, a copy of the notice under section 85 of that Act must also be given to the relevant building surveyor. (See Form 4)
